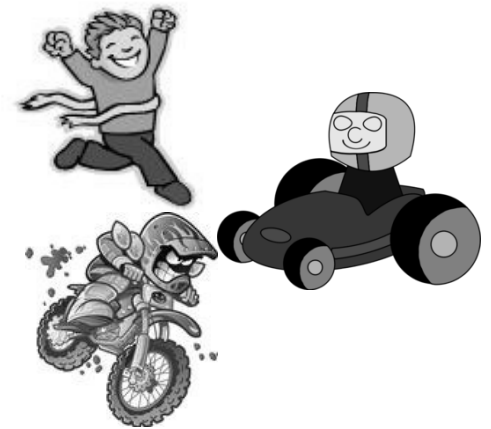

Water Days: We take a break from sweaty summer activities every Thursday to cool down at the creek with a water slide down the hill and water activities. You must bring a change of clothes and towel to participate.
