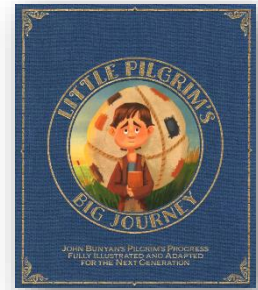


For Christmas last year, our four-year-old son Micah received *Little Pilgrim's Big Journey*, a retelling of John Bunyan's classic work, *Pilgrim's Progress*. If you know Micah, you know he's full of energy and is not known for sitting still very long. But, amazingly, he sits still for this book! At his insistence we read the entire 200-page book to him each day for close to two weeks. Even now it's his favorite book and he'll tell anyone who will listen all about his favorite chapter, in which Christian fights the enemy Apollyon while wearing the armor of God.



Micah's reaction isn't unique; the book has hundreds of glowing reviews on Amazon (4.9 stars). So what makes this version of *Pilgrim's Progress* so special?

- Beautiful illustrations: Every page spread is filled with a full-color drawing that catches kids' attention, with just a few paragraphs of text.
- Fast pace: the adapter includes many of the characters and lessons of Bunyan's story but keeps it concise and understandable for kids.
- Chapter summaries with key teachings, bible references, and discussion questions to facilitate parent-child conversations
- High-quality, durable hardback



Coming Soon in Spanish

The success of this work has meant that over the last few years, thousands of young English-speaking children have been drawn into Bunyan's clear presentation of the Gospel and the Christian life. Now, a project is underway to make it available to Spanish-speaking children for the first time.

A leading Spanish-language evangelical publisher, Poiema Publications, has translated the text of *Little Pilgrim's Big Journey* and intend to publish a Spanish edition comparable to the English edition. I have read and provided feedback on a draft version of their translation, and I can attest that it is extremely well done.

Of course, one of the major barriers to producing a book like this is the up-front cost. To alleviate this and allow for a larger, more cost-effective print run, the publisher is accepting bulk pre-orders of the book from partners like us. As a church, we would like to raise \$2,000, in order to donate 100 copies of the book to churches and families connected with missionaries we support in Latin America. To help us reach this goal, a sponsor has agreed to match dollar for dollar the first \$1,000 of Gospel Fellowship donations.
